Our Mount Eden cuttings were obtained by Richard Sanford around 1970 from the Santa Cruz Mountain vineyard of the same name. The wine is bright and brilliant, perhaps the prettiest and most feminine of our three single-clone bottlings... Lots of flowery aromas, spicy herbal notes and high-toned cherry, raspberry fruit... fairly “grippy” with tannins right now, it seems that 2 or 3 years of bottle age will contribute to its overall composure. Classic with grilled salmon, lighter roasts, French onion soup (yeah baby), etc.
