Exhibiting the bright energy of exuberant youth, this wine is like a swift arrow let loose from the bow... right on target with the tropical fruit aromatics characteristic of Chardonnay from Santa Barbara County. Here we have a citrus-apple acidity and a just-barely noticeable oak presence. This is the firm, angular and crisp side of the Chardonnay spectrum, which is especially complementary with food to balance its mouth-watering freshness. Try with crustaceans and shellfish, grilled or roasted fish with fruit salsas, spicy chicken curry, baked brie (or other creamy-rich cheeses).
