

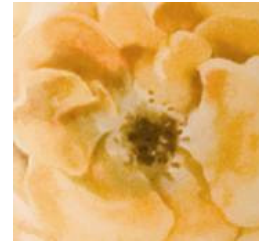

Right off the bat you get a faceful of fresh Meyer lemon underscored by a slate-y mineralness, and enhanced by a subtle wildflower aroma. While more citrus in the nose, you find more stone-fruit on the palate, showing nectarine-peach-melon characteristics, all framed within a crisp texture and bright acidity. Just under two acres of vines, grown organically, are the source for this wine. Fermentation in stainless steel without malolactic preserves the fresh essence of the grapes themselves.
