Planted in 2000, close to the western end of the Sta. Rita Hills AVA, this 100-acre organically-farmed vineyard is home to six different pinot noir clones; this bottling represents what are felt to be three of the “best”, and this is the first release from the vineyard. Bold, smooth, rich, and spicy, here is pinot noir for the aficionado: good depth, balanced structure, richness of flavor and, again, sturdy acidity all contribute to a great wine for a few years in the cellar (or enjoy tonight!) Beef, lamb, game, hearty poultry, rich sauces, big cheeses would all be welcome companions here.
