Pinot Noir

Santa Rita Hills

Produced from grapes from our organically-farmed estate vineyard, there are delightful aromas and flavors of berries, cherries, and plums with intriguing spice and smoke notes in this still young pinot noir. Lively acidity speaks to an age-worthiness and compatibility with a wide variety of foods. Six different clonal selections of pinot noir, all from organically grown grapes within the Sta. Rita Hills AVA, were utilized in the making of this wine. Aging in French oak barrels that were used previously keeps the heaviness of oak at bay.

Steak-y seafood (salmon, halibut, swordfish) would share company here, as would soft cheeses, anything from off the grill, coq au vin, ragout of mushrooms, etc.

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Committed to Sustainable Farming. All of our estate vineyards are certified organic by CCOF.
